We recognise that the games industry is as diverse as the games we make and the players who love them, and want our values and actions to reflect that to the broader industry.


The Arcade has taken the following steps to encourage a safe workplace:


- All of our bathrooms (regardless of gender) are equipped with free sanitary products and sanitary bins.

We are always striving to achieve a higher standard for our inclusion practices, and know that our work is never done.


